

The TTA Legacy Scholarship Information for Applicants

General

The TTA Legacy Scholarship offers financial aid to children, stepchildren, and grandchildren of current TTA members. The scholarship is funded and administered by the TTA. The Scholarship and Awards Committee will review all applications and select the scholarship recipient. All decisions of the committee will be final. This scholarship will be awarded at the TTA annual conference and a check will be made payable to the recipient.

Eligibility

1. One or more of the applicant's parents, stepparents, or grandparents must have been a TTA member for at least one year and must currently be a member of the TTA.
2. Students who are not eligible for any other TTA scholarships may apply. (non-turf major)
3. Applicant must be enrolled full-time at an accredited institution of higher learning.
4. Previous recipients are ineligible to apply.

Criteria for Selection

Selection will be based on academic achievement, extracurricular and community involvement and leadership, outside employment, financial need, and student's essay.
